Whereas, the governor of the state of New Jersey through Executive Order number 150 has authorized outdoor dining and the serving of alcoholic beverages outside of the current limits of the licensed premises; and

Whereas, Executive Order number 150 and the related Executive Directive number 20 – 014 set forth certain regulations to be followed regarding outdoor dining and the serving of alcoholic beverages outside of the current limits of the licensed premises; and

Whereas, the borough of Caldwell (the "Borough") is required to provide enforcement of the rules and regulations established by the state for this purpose;

Whereas, the Borough of Caldwell shall extend outdoor dining allowances until June 30, 2021;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved By The Mayor And Council Of The Borough Of Caldwell New Jersey That:

1. Any business wishing to provide outdoor dining and/or the serving of alcoholic beverages outside of the current limits of the licensed premises shall be required to file a complete application in substantially the form is attached hereto with the Borough zoning official and to have such application approved by the zoning official prior to the commencement of the delivery of such services; and

2. In conducting such business, each business operator shall be required to comply with all of the terms of Executive Order number 150 and the related Executive Directive number 20 – 014 and all applicable municipal ordinances of the Borough.
