

EXHIBIT D

Approved Replacement Trees

The following trees have characteristics that make them acceptable to the Borough of Caldwell for use as replacement trees in the situations described below. Notwithstanding their acceptability to the Borough, the Borough shall only use these trees to the extent that such use is financially feasible for the Borough, and that the desired trees are available in the New Jersey area at normal prices. To the extent that such conditions exist, the Borough will do everything possible to utilize the genus and species of tree as requested by the affected property owner. If the Borough is unable to utilize the requested tree, it shall notify the property owner and shall not proceed unless the property owner agrees to the use of such genus and species of tree as is then available.

1. Category 1: For tree lawns less than 30 inches in width

2. Category 2: For tree lawns 30 inches to 48 inches in width

All trees in Category 1 may be used in Category 2 locations. The following may also be used.
