Minutes

Christine Gurriere called the meeting to order at 7:12 p.m. in accordance with the Sunshine Laws. She welcomed Nancy Hauser to our Committee. Christine Gurriere asked if everyone read the minutes of the November 13, 2023 meeting. A motion was made by Sue Marinucci and seconded by Maria Camerino to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All agreed.
